Maria Sepsis - BOSH updates

- **b.o.s.h.** (Benefactors of St. Helen.) is a 501c3 non-profit and fundraising organization with a mission to support S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) and Athletic programs in our school and our community.
- **B.o.s.h.** has raised over \$250,000 and has assisted in purchasing new computers, broadcasting equipment for student programs, classroom improvements, teacher incentives, supported Teen Leadership programs as well as many other school projects.
- SHS Staff Holiday Fund: B.O.S.H. is once again taking on the Holiday staff bonuses. Last year through the AMAZING generosity of the SHS families, we were able to give each staff member a bonus of \$1100. Keep an eye out for more info coming this week.
- Stemstep 5k: We are hopefully we will be able to host the event this year! The Stemstep5k traditionally takes place in Humboldt Park in May. The events is a 5k run/1k family walk. The event raises over \$60,000 to support S T F M at St. Helen.

Shannon Lovett~Health and Safety Team

- Reminders to remain vigilant regarding gatherings (particularly indoors), ensure masks on properly - several Catholic schools are currently under classwide quarantines due to COVID.
- Travel to orange states (or international) submit negative tests to
 <u>health@sthelenchicago.org</u> before returning to in-person (Chicago travel advisory will be updated Tuesday, November 23rd).
- The <u>CDC recommends</u> the Pfizer COVID vaccine for children age 5-11yo. The vaccine will be two doses, at least 21 days apart. Each dose is 1/3 the dosing for adults. A child is considered fully vaccinated 10 days after their second dose. We encourage all eligible to consider getting vaccinated.
- Encourage flu vaccines for those eligible.
- We will maintain our current protocols (eg, masks) until a future time when we have more data from CDC and others.

Mike Kozlowski~Athletics Updates

- Successful Cross Country season wrapping up
 - o 6th season, marked with new uniforms
 - First time we qualified a full team to the State Meet, boys who finished 6th out of 24 teams.
 - o Luke Sutkus (3rd) and Jack Ray (13th) received All State honors
 - First time we qualified a girl to the State Meet, Kate Lawrence
 - o Post season meets; NXR, Kentucky and EastBay at WI-Parkside
- Basketball season kicking off
 - 7 teams total this season
 - First games were this past weekend, and will continue this upcoming weekend
 - League rules in place currently limit spectators to 1 per player. The rules is to be reviewed over Christmas break.
 - Beginning to look at replacing the basketball uniforms that we have inherited
